Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order directing respondent No.2 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members with a further direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner and her family members, who are time and again being called by respondent No.3 to the police station on the pretext of recording the statement and threatening the petitioner to involve her and her family members in a false case if the petitioner does not compromise the matter with respondent No.5.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on earlier occasion this Court had disposed of the petition bearing CRM-M-41507-2021 filed by the petitioner vide order dated 04.10.2021 with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner. He submits that in pursuance to the same, FIR No.0096 dated 29.11.2021 under Sections 376 and 506 IPC was registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural. However, now the Investigating agency is calling the petitioner-complainant time and again and make her to sit in the

police Station in order to pressurize her to compromise the matter.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to strictly abide by the statutory provisions and consider this petition as a representation. Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is further directed to listen personally to the grievances of the petitioner and take a conscious decision on the same, as per law.
