By this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of his grievance, the petitioner has made various representations to respondents no.2 and 3, a copy of the last one having been annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition, shown to be dated 17.01.2022.

He further submits that despite resolutions having been passed by the Gram Panchayats of two villages (copies Annexures P-1 and P-2), respondents no.4 to 7 are threatening the petitioner qua completion of the link road in terms of the said resolutions.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (respondent no. 2), to look into the grievance of the petitioner and to take action as may be warranted as per law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
