Learned State counsel has submitted the status-report (by way of the affidavit of the Financial Commissioner and Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats), along-with the Policy of Faecal Sludge and Septage Management in Rural Areas and these documents are taken on the record. He points out that the above-said Policy has already been notified by the State Government vide the notification dated 03.11.2022 (Annexure R-1).
