Both the parties are present today in Court.

After the matter settled between the parties in view of the settlement/compromise, their first motion statements were recorded in the Court on 07.09.2022.

As per the settlement/compromise, the matter between the parties was settled in a total sum of Rs.40,00,000/- (rupees forty lacs only) to be paid by the respondent-husband to the appellant-wife towards permanent alimony. On 07.9.2022, when the first motion statements of the parties were recorded, out of total agreed amount of Rs.40,00,000/- towards permanent alimony, Rs.10,00,000/- (rupees ten lac only) was paid by the

respondent-husband to the appellant-wife in the shape of demand draft dated 19.9.2022, which was handed over to the appellant-wife on 27.9.2022. Today i.e.31.10.2022, the second motion statements of the parties have also been recorded and in terms of the settlement/compromise, rest of the amount i.e. Rs.30,00,000/- (rupees thirty lac only), out of total agreed amount of Rs.40,00,000/- (as Rs.10,00,000/- have already been paid) has been paid to the appellant-wife by the respondent-husband and the appellant-wife has also handed over the keys and vacant possession of House No.1186, Urban Estate, Phase-I, Jalandhar to the respondent-husband as agreed in the settlement/agreement. As per the statements, recorded before this Court, both the parties undertake to comply with the terms and conditions of the same and shall remain bound by the terms of the settlement/agreement.

In view of the aforesaid development, the appellant-wife seeks withdrawal of the present appeal.

The appellant-wife is permitted to do so and the present appeal is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.

Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
