[1] Prayer in the petition is for taking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2019 in CWP No.20905 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2019 reveals that CWP No.20905 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the allotment of General Provident Fund numbers to the petitioners within 60 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners contends that order, Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2019 in CWP No.20905 of 2019 has been complied with and the petitioners have been allotted GPF numbers, therefore, the petitioners do not press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

[5] Contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
