Present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 68 dated 02.08.2016, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga on the basis of compromise dated 01.12.2020.

Vide order dated 15.12.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 02.02.2022 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between

the parties is genuine and voluntary.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 68 dated 02.08.2016, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
