This petition was filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 83 dated 19.5.2019, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 31.1.2022, following order was passed:

"The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter-alia relies on the grant of anticipatory bail by this Court to co-accused-Kuldip @ Kala, Manvir Singh, Harpreet Singh and Gurpreet Singh who like the petitioners had not been attributed any specific injury. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the case of the petitioners is on a still better footing as after investigation the petitioners had also been declared innocent by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rehat Bir Singh Mann, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 14.07.2022.

Subject to the petitioners' appearing before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 10 days from today they shall be granted ad interim bail to the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate's satisfaction."

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submits that the petitioners have appeared before the Court concerned and were released on bail.

In view of subsequent development, no further orders are called for.

The petition is disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
