1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.04.2019, in CWP No.4226 of 2017 in case titled as Paramjit Kaur vs. Punjab State Warehousing Corporation and another.

2. A perusal of the order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4226 of 2017 was disposed of on the statement of the respondent that in case any representation was filed by the petitioner, the same would be duly considered and appropriate orders would be passed on the same within two months from the date of receipt of said representation.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the notice issued to respondent No.2, respondent No.2 has decided the representation filed by the petitioner and granted the benefits admissible to the petitioner vide order dated 04.07.2022 passed by the Manager, Punjab State Warehousing Corporation regarding payment of interest on retirement dues of the deceased husband of the petitioner,

therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. The same is not opposed to by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
