Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.149 dated 12.8.2019, under Section 21/22/25 NDPS Act, Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner suffered heart ailment on 27.12.2021 and requires immediate surgical intervention.

On 3.2.2022, learned State counsel sought time to verify the ground raised by the petitioner. Short reply dated 9.2.2022, by way of affidavit of Rahul Raja, Superintendent, Women Jail, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the State alongwith medical report of the petitioner issued by Dr.Jasneev Sandhu, Medical Officer, Women Jail, Ludhiana, according to which, the petitioner is advised Coronary Angiography by Govt. Rajindra Hospital, Patiala.

Considering the above ground raised for interim bail as well as

the report submitted by the State, this Court finds that the limited prayer made by the petitioner deserves acceptance.

Resultantly, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on interim bail for four weeks in the above case, subject to her furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender herself before the concerned Jail Authorities on 25.3.2022, before 5.00 p.m.

Petition is disposed off.
