This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No. 4 to enter names of the petitioners in the register of the Haryana State Pharmacy Council and to issue licence to the petitioners so that they can work to earn their livelihood and may apply for some government job.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have already filed a detailed representation dated 07.11.2021 (Annexure P7) before the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken thereon; and the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the same and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4, to decide representation dated 07.11.2021 (Anneuxre P7) of the petitioners and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
