1. Prayer in the petition is fortaking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.09.2019, in CWP-19591-2019.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.09.20219, reveals that CWP-19591-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 07.08.2018, by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel contends that although the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondents to do the needful but now the respondents have passed speaking order deciding the claim made in the legal notice and have also released the benefits admissible to the petitioners, therefore, the petitioners do not wish to press the instant petition.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as
