The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to get release the detenue, as named in the headnote of the petition, who is stated to be 20 years of age and is daughter of the present petitioner.

Mr. Priyanshu Kamra, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos. 7 and 10 and has filed memo of appearance, same is taken on record. He has submitted that in fact, in the present case, the detenue is a major as her date of birth is 22.10.2002 and she has married one Sanjeev Kumar on 15.01.2022 and the said Sanjeev Kumar and the detenue have filed CRWP-541-2022 which was disposed of vide order dated 20.01.2022

in which the factum of marriage was noticed and the marriage certificate as well as the photographs of marriage were also appended therein.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition stands disposed of as not pressed.
