The petitioner has been convicted *inter alia* under Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 10 years. His appeal is pending. The passport is due to expire in April 2022 and, thus, he has filed this writ petition.

According to the relevant law, writ petition is not maintainable in a case where appeal against conviction is pending. The petitioner will have to approach the concerned Court for the necessary relief.
