[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-6, dated 23.10.2019, in CWP No.30670 of 2019 in case titled as '**Dr. Harnam Singh Madan** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-6) reveals that CWP No.30670 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the representations submitted by the petitioner in the light of order relied upon by the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, the claim of the petitioner was accepted, then the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the

filed by him, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
