Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 71 dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Profession Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar and and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 22.01.2020, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 06.03.2020 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate

First Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between the parties is voluntary, without any inducement, coercion or pressure.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 71 dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Profession Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
