The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 225 dated 09.09.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 506 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 29.01.2021, the arrest of the petitioners was stayed and thereafter, the said order was continuing and on 17.03.2022, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 17.03.2022, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has

not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 17.03.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
