Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.167 dated 25.07.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 325 and 326 of IPC have been added later on) at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

On 14.07.2022, this Court had directed the petitioner to join the investigation on 22.07.2022 at 11:00 AM.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the abovesaid order dated 14.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Raj

Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and also the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, the present petition is allowed and in the event of arrest, the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer and the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail application.
