[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.07.2019 in CWP No.10882 of 2019 in case titled as Harjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.10882 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 herein to look into the representations filed by the petitioner as also to take into account the writ petition as a supplementary representation and decide the claim made therein by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case and at the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representations filed has been decided and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
