Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0524 dated 24.12.2021, under Sections 313, 323, 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula, Haryana.

By virtue of the order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anita has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.01.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
