Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.9 dated 05.01.2022, under Sections 376, 323 of IPC, registered at Police Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

By virtue of the order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
