[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.10.2019, in CWP-PIL No.212 of 2019 in case titled as '**H.C. Arora, Advocate**versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-PIL No.212 of 2019 was disposed of by directing representation moved by the petitioner to be decided by the competent authority at the earliest.

[3] At the outset, the petitioner appearing in person states that order dated 20.04.2020 was passed by the respondent, rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 20.04.2020 by way of appropriate proceeding in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of the petitioner appearing in person, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not
