The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the illegal action of respondents No. 3 and 4, for not allowing the petitioner to re-join his services with respondent No. 4, after the expiry of 15 days from dated 15.01.2019, when respondent No. 4 sent the petitioner on leave for 15 days without giving any reason or notice and not making payment of his salary amounting to Rs.69,812/- for the months of November 2016 to January, 2017.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner despite the fact that counsel for the petitioner was informed about the date of hearing fixed for today. The same was the situation on the previous date. Not only that, the order sheets also show that on several occasions as well, counsel for the petitioner had not appeared.

From the above, it is obvious that the petitioner has lost interest in the case.
