[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.08.2018, in CRR(F) No.398 of 2017.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the grant of divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, the parties have parted ways amicably, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
