[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/3 dated 26.11.2018 in CWP No.29742 of 2018 in case titled as Jai Karan vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/3 reveals that CWP No.29742 of 2018 was disposed of by directing the appellate authority to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG states that the instant petition is misconceived since the appeal filed by the petitioner was decided vide order, Annexure R/2 dated 26.10.2020 and said decision was challenged by the petitioner by way of CWP No.6816 of 2021 which was disposed of on 23.07.2021 (Annexure R/3) by setting aside order dated 26.10.2020 (Annexure R/2) and directing the appellate authority to decide the matter afresh by passing a speaking order in accordance with law after hearing

the petition within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in pursuance of the same, order, Annexure R/6 dated 08.06.2022 was passed accepting the appeal of the petitioner.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order, Annexure R/6 dated 08.06.2022 having been passed and the claim of the petitioner having been accepted, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, besides the explanation given by the respondent, the petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
