AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 65 dated 18.7.2018, registered under Sections 21, 22 and 61 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar.

The petitioner was found in possession of 220 intoxicant tablets. He was granted interim bail by Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar till the receipt of Chemical Examiner's report. On receipt of the report from Chemical Examiner, the petitioner never surrendered before the trial court, rather has moved this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within two weeks from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within two weeks from today

and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
