LISA GILL, J.

Petitioner, in this case, has filed this writ petition being aggrieved of respondents not allowing her to proceed on Child Care Leave (for short “CCL”).

While issuing notice of motion in this case on 29.01.2021, it was directed that the petitioner shall continue to be on CCL till the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the State submits that pursuant to order dated 29.01.2021, order dated 30.12.2021 has been passed whereby CCL was granted to the petitioner from 17.02.2021 to 25.05.2021. It is submitted that in view of order dated 30.12.2021, present petition is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been unable to contact the petitioner and has no instructions.

In view of order dated 30.12.2021, this writ petition is disposed of as infructuous. Needless to say, in case, petitioner has any subsisting grievance, liberty is afforded to her to move an appropriate application within four weeks from today.
