The petitioner is respondent's husband. He assails the correctness of the order dated 11.11.2021 passed by the trial court. As per the aforesaid order, the petitioner has been directed to pay the amount of maintenance.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that since the main divorce petition was dismissed in default on 12.07.2019, therefore, the interim orders passed for grant of maintenance cannot be implemented.

The order of interim maintenance creates a right in favour of the wife and a child and unless the payment is made and the liability stands. These orders can be implemented by filing an execution petition.

Hence, dismissed.
