MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.112 dated 10.09.2021 under Sections 406 and 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 08.02.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the allegations in the FIR the complainant had paid a sum of Rs. 10, 50,000/- to the accused persons upon their inducement and promise to send complainant abroad. Learned counsel submits that the said transaction took place in the year 2019 and the petitioner accused had received a sum of Rs. 3,43,000/- approximately and he is willing to settle the dispute with the complainant. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner would bring a demand draft of Rs. 3 lac in favour of the complainant on the next date of hearing. Notice of motion for 17.02.2022. At this stage, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as the petitioner is unable to arrange the money to be paid to the complainant, therefore, he has instructions to withdraw this petition.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
