AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 2, dated 7th January, 2021, under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

This Court vide order dated 28th January, 2022 granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating.

Mr. Abdul Aziz, Advocate appeared on behalf of the complainant and moved an application i.e. CRM-5820-2022 for impleadment as respondent No.2. He has been heard at length. He opposed the prayer for confirmation of bail.

However, considering that custody of the petitioner is not

required by the investigating agency, the interim bail granted on 28th January, 2022 is made absolute.

In view of the fact that main petition is disposed of, the pending applications are accordingly disposed of.
