Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.269 dated 28.12.2021, registered for offences under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab, Annexure P-1/T.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 11.02.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has paid an amount of Rs.25,000/- by way of expenses to the complainant-respondent No.2 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, the mediation proceedings have remained unsuccessful.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Jatinder, State counsel submits that the articles as deposited by the petitioner in his affidavit dated 31.01.2022 have been recovered. Still further, upon instructions, he submits that as the petitioner has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 11.02.2022 passed by this Court, cooperated with the Investigating Agency and recoveries have been effected, he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 11.02.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
