Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.472 dated 10.12.2021 under Sections 13(1), 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the basis of information received by the police from Gau Rakshak Dal, Delhi that two vehicles will be passing through KMP carrying animals, which are transported from Nuh, Mewat to Rajasthan. After some time, one truck and one pick-up were seen coming and on stopping the same, the truck driver fled away. Three cows were found in the pick-up and 13 cows,

8 oxes, 3 calves and 1 male calf were found in the truck. Driver of the pick-up namely Ravi and helper Ravinder were arrested.

Learned counsel further submits that one co-accused namely Akhil has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 10.01.2022 passed in CRM-M-552-2022. It is also submitted that the petitioner as well as co-accused Ravinder had sought permission from Municipal Corporation, South, Delhi to transport the cow from Village Badu Sarai to Amar Singh in Village Alwar. It is next submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 month and 23 days and has no such history of involvement in any other case and the investigation qua him is complete.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated 03.02.2022 filed in the Court today, has not disputed the fact that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
