The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the daughter of the petitioner as named in the headnote of the petition who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent No. 5.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, as per his instructions, the daughter of the petitioner is a minor as she was born on 28.02.1997 and was traced on 01.02.2022 and as per her statement, she has disclosed that she had married respondent No. 5 Moti Ram Desai on 21.01.2022 and thereafter, she was taken for medical examination but she refused to get her medical examination done and the said alleged detainee was also taken before the

Magistrate where she has given a statement that she is residing with her husband- respondent No. 5 out of her own choice and without any pressure. It is further pointed out that even in the FIR, which has been registered against respondent No. 5, cancellation report is being prepared by the police.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is dismissed.
