Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8. The certificate and photographs evidencing their marriage, are on record as Annexure P-3 and P-4, respectively. Petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar.

On the asking of this Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At this stage, Mr. Aman Goyal, Advocate, puts in an appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.8 through e-mail. Print out of the same is taken on record.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, to decide the representation dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner No.1, and grant protection to the petitioners, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

At this stage, learned counsel for respondents No.8 submits that respondent No.8 wants to have an interaction with petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not have any objection to the said prayer provided such interaction is allowed only in the premises of Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel submits that respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, would make necessary arrangements for the interaction between the petitioners and respondent No.8 at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Keeping in view the above, respondent No.8 and the petitioners are directed to appear before respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police

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Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, for the interaction on 03.02.2022 or any other date as per their convenience.

Respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, is directed to make all necessary arrangements for the same and also to ensure that no untoward incident takes place.
