1. This writ petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner to attend the last rites of his father who died on 22.1.2022.
2. Learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Gurpreet Singh, SHO, Thana Sadar, Ludhiana has corroborated the fact that the father of the petitioner has passed away and the Bhog ceremony is to be held from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm on 31.1.2022.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that keeping in view the nature of the case, he would not oppose any condition.
4. In these circumstances, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the authorities to allow the petitioner to attend the Bhog ceremony of his father with adequate police escort on 31.1.2022 from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm.

5. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
