Through this revision, the petitioner-Gurdaspur Improvement Trust prays for setting aside the order dated 19.04.2016 passed by the Executing Court while dismissing its objections against the order of ejectment. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the revision petition is rendered infructuous as the execution petition has been disposed of being fully satisfied vide order dated 15.12.2021. However, the learned counsel representing the respondents submits that some amount is yet to be recovered.

2. This Court is only hearing a revision petition against the order dismissing the objections filed by the petitioner. The respondent will have to avail his remedy before the appropriate Court.

3. With the observations made above, the present revision petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The miscellaneous application(s) pending, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
