On 29.01.2021, when the case was taken up for hearing, counsel for respondents had stated that the Review Application (Annexure P-25) could have been filed by applicant, which is still pending before the Appellate Authority but since the said authority had not been notified, notice was issued and the counsel for the State was called upon to seek instructions.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, has brought to the notice of the Court notification dated 20.01.2022 vide which the competent authority has been notified. He, on instructions from Mr. Sunil Khosla, Law Officer, Department of Panchayat, further states that on verification of the records, it has been found that the Review Application is not on record.

If that be so, let the petitioner file an application for review now, which shall be considered and decided by the Appellate Authority at the earliest preferably within a period of six weeks from the first appearance of the parties.

Status quo with regard to possession, as granted by this Court,
shall be maintained till the decision of the Review Application.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
