AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Aggrieved of the conviction order dated 19th January, 2018, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, petitioner filed an appeal alongwith an application for suspension of sentence.

Petitioner was granted bail subject to furnishing of surety and deposit of twenty percent of compensation amount. Aggrieved of the condition of deposit the present petition was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time restricts his prayer that the petitioner be given three weeks time to comply with the impugned orders i.e. to deposit twenty percent of compensation amount.

The petition is disposed of.

The time granted in impugned order is extended by three weeks from today.

It is further submitted that Appellate Court be directed to expeditiously decide the appeal.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to make a request before the concerned Court for disposal of the appeal.

In case, the petitioner fails to deposit the amount within three weeks, bail granted to the petitioner shall be treated to be cancelled.
