MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present contempt petition is filed under Article 215 of the Constitution read with Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against respondents for willful disobedience of order dated 23.12.2021 passed in CWP No. 24112 of 2021.

Undoubtedly, *ex-facie*, the action of respondents-contemnors while issuing the posting orders in favour of 135 candidates for the post(s) of Assistant Professors despite the interim stay order dated 03.12.2021, is not acceptable. At the same time, it cannot be ignored that while allowing CWP No. 22446 of 2021 & other connected cases, vide order of even date, Memo. dated 18.10.2021, Public Notice dated 19.10.2021, 33 separate advertisements along with entire selection process, including the consequent appointments as well as posting orders have been quashed and set-aside.

In view of above, taking a lenient view, this Court does not deem it appropriate to proceed further in the matter.

As a result thereof, contempt petition is disposed off.

Rule stands discharged.
