Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 61 dated 08.08.2021, registered under Sections 307, 120-B IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 31.01.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the orders dated 31.01.2022 and 26.04.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satnam Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for

any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 31.01.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
