Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.60 dated 14.2.2020 registered under Section 174-A of IPC at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala on the ground that the trial court has issued her non-bailable warrants of arrest.

Admittedly, in the present case, the petitioner remained absent from the trial Court in the aforesaid criminal case on 26.11.2021. Counsel for the petitioner contended that she failed to appear in the Court on the concerned date as she noted down wrong date of hearing as 29.11.2021 instead of 26.11.2021. It is further contended that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings in the trial Court.

In view of above, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is a young lady aged about 27-28 years of age, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear in the trial Court on or before the next date fixed there and on her appearance, she is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction.
