1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of a mandamus hence directing respondent No. 2 to give protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of accused, facing trial in NIA case, pending in the Court of Special Judge, NIA, SAS Nagar (Mohali), as also from respondents No. 3 to 7.
2. The learned State Counsel, does not have any objection, to an order being made by this Court to the respondents concerned, to look into and decide through a speaking order, representation Annexure P-2.
3. Consequently, this Court directs the respondents concerned, to within three weeks hereafter, hence decide Annexure P-2, through a speaking order.
