Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.70 dated 21.06.2018 under Sections 22, 25 and 29 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, (Sections 25 and 29 of NDPS Act added later on), Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 52-A of Prison Act, 1894 (added later on) registered at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar (Punjab).

Learned State counsel has stated that the prosecution has discharged the burden by examining all the 26 witnesses and the case before the trial Court is now fixed for defence evidence and arguments.
