JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.553 dated 08.11.2021 registered under Sections 457, 380, 411 IPC at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the said matter. It is argued that the petitioner has not been nominated as a person who committed the theft or stolen the gold articles and cash. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he melted gold articles and converted into bricks and coins. It is submitted that there is no other case pending against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the matter has been investigated and challan stands presented, therefore, prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State would oppose grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that the allegations levelled

against the petitioner are serious in nature, however, he does not dispute the fact that the matter has been investigated and challan stands presented.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and deem it appropriate to allow regular bail to the petitioner considering the fact that the matter has been investigated and challan stands presented and trial will likely to take some time to conclude.

Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his execution of personal/surety bonds of Rs.2 lakhs each to the satisfaction of concerned trial court/Duty Magistrate.

However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
