The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of the private respondents.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that representation dated 11.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into

the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated dated 11.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
