The petitioner herein is seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider her case for appointment as Constable by contending that she had obtained more marks than the selected candidates.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this respect, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 20.12.2020, Annexure P-5, before respondent No.2, but no decision has been taken thereon till date. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case said representation is decided in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Mohit Kapoor, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 20.12.2020, Annexure P-5, of the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
