The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, would submit that for his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

At this stage, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and would submit that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, to take a decision on the representation dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
