In a suit for grant of decree of partition of the joint property filed in the year 2010, an application filed by the petitioners (plaintiffs) has been dismissed while recording various reasons. It has been noticed that the petitioners did not implead all the co-owners in the suit for partition for grant of decree of partition. When the case was at a fag end, the petitioners filed an application and the Court dismissed the same.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel representing the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the suit with liberty to file a fresh one after impleading the proper parties.

Learned counsel representing the respondents have no objection.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the suit itself is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
