The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0010 dated 11.01.2022, registered under Sections 294, 307, 506 IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the compromise/affidavit of respondent No.2/complainant to the said effect has been annexed at Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Santosh Kumar Yadav, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant by filing memo of appearance through e-mail and print out of the same is taken on record. He admits the factum of compromise having been effected between the parties.

After having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is disposed of. However, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) *that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
