The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 9 dated
09.01.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 120-B, 509 IPC and
Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Titram,
District Kaithal.

On 15.11.2022, this Court was pleased to pass the following
order:

*“Learned State counsel has submitted that although, the
petitioner has joined the investigation but is still required for
further investigation.*

*The petitioner is again directed to join the investigation
before the concerned Investigating Officer on 22.11.2022 at
11:00 AM.*

Adjourned to 14.12.2022.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner does not cooperate with the investigation, then, the case would be considered on merits on the next date of hearing. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the abovesaid order dated 15.11.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.04.2022 is ordered to be made absolute.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail application.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
