The defendant in a suit for specific performance of the agreement to sell is the petitioner herein. The suit was filed by Sh. Avtar Singh (respondent herein). During the pendency of the suit, the defendant admitted the claim of the plaintiff and agreed to execute the sale deed. However, no order was passed by the trial Court, hence, this revision petition was filed.

During the pendency of the revision petition, the matter was referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre. Therein, a settlement was reached and the plaintiff agreed to withdraw the suit, subject to the refund of the Court fee. However, the Court fee could not be refunded to the plaintiff. Thus, there was a delay in withdrawal of the suit.

The learned counsels representing the parties do not dispute the correctness of the aforesaid settlement arrived at through Mediation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order in the revision petition is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
